How Live TV Works

Ever wonder how it's possible to watch something live on TV?

It all starts in the Homework Express TV studio, where our three studio cameras change light and colors into electronic signals, while microphones change sound into similar signals. A director selects the best picture and decides what sound should go with it.

Those signals are sent out through a thin piece of cable called "Fiber" to another building at YSU.

The signals full of information are amplified and sent to Time Warner, Adelphia and Armstrong Cable providers. They send the signal to your house, where your TV sorts out all of the information and you can watch Homework Express!

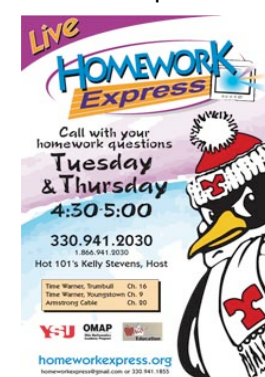
