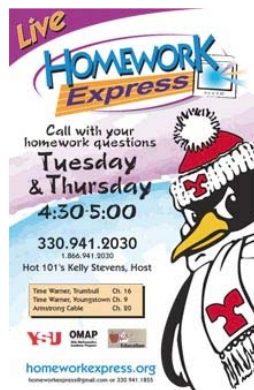
A special feature to the first show of the season will be guest Katie Dean, a Lake Milton State Park officer. Dean will be part of a segment involving snakes and other reptiles.

Ohio Graduation Tests

Homework Express teachers frequently mention the OGT’s, or the Ohio Graduation Tests. These standardized tests replace the Ohio Ninth Grade Proficiency Test and are aligned to Ohio’s new academic content standards, adopted by the State Board of Education. Aspects tested include English and language arts, math, science and social studies through the tenth grade level.

The Class of 2007 is the first class responsible for taking the OGT and passing all five tests as a graduation requirement.

Homework Express is committed to providing students with help passing the OGTs.
