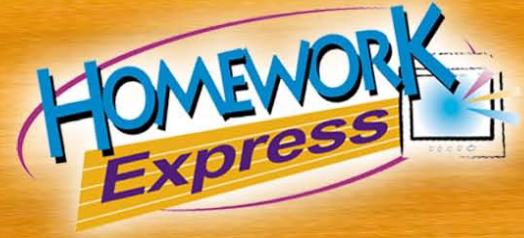

YSU presently has nearly 14,000 students enrolled in both undergrad and graduate programs.

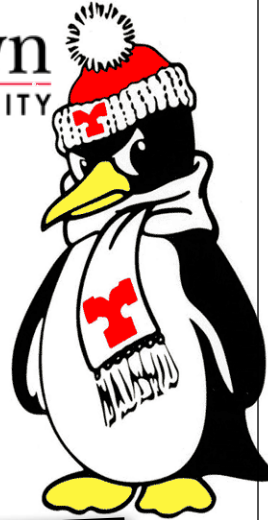
Youngstown State offers nearly 120 major courses of study which allows for many individuals with diverse aspirations to find a career that best suits them. Within those courses of study are programs
