** A student may satisfy the MATH requirement by passing an approved course, by passing a higher-level mathematics course, or by passing a mathematics CLEP or AP exam. Approved courses are MATH 2623 and MATH 2625. Higher-level approved substitute courses include: MATH 1549, 1570, 1571, 1572, 1581H, 1585H, 2652, 2665, 2670; and 2686H.

*** Because students in Music Performance often change majors to Music Education, PSYCH 1560 (General Psychology) is recommended as a course selection in the Personal and Social Responsibility Domain. It is required of students in Education.

**** Students may take A&S 2600 to fulfill the lab requirement. Otherwise, students should enroll in at least one approved substitute course and its accompanying lab.
